A RESOLUTION

1 Requesting the creation of a Blood Pressure Down Shift Program; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, earlier in this decade, the United States Department of Transportation revised

3 the hypertension guidelines for obtaining a commercial driver's license; and

WHEREAS, hidden medical dangers such as high blood pressure, diabetes, and high
cholesterol can cause fatal accidents on the road and endanger the lives and well-being of
Georgia citizens: and

6 Georgia citizens; and

WHEREAS, transportation service providers such as MARTA, GRTA, GDOT, trucking
companies, and other transportation providers can develop a customized program to identify
health risks in potential and current commercially certified drivers and create new guidelines
for obtaining or renewing a commercial license which will include health risks of the

11 applicant; and

WHEREAS, a Blood Pressure Down Shift Program would assist in identifying, preventing,and containing such health risks.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that 15 the members of this body request that transportation providers adopt a program to educate 16 applicants for commercial drivers' licenses on the health risks that could lead to an accident 17 on the road and that creates new standards for obtaining and renewing commercial licenses 18 with a focus on identifying health risks that could lead to accidents before such licenses will

19 be issued.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
 and directed to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to members of the public and

the press.
