- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Clyde Lee Herndon; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
- 3 with the passing of Mr. Clyde Lee Herndon on February 27, 2009; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Herndon was born on September 30, 1932, in Murray County, Georgia, a
- 5 beloved son of the late James G. Herndon and the late Elizabeth Langley Herndon; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
- 7 States Marine Corps during the Korean War, worked as a mine foreman at the Tennessee
- 8 Copper Company, and was a co-owner of North Georgia Seamless Guttering for several
- 9 years before his retirement in 2001; and
- 10 WHEREAS, a man with a deep sense of devotion to his faith and community, Mr. Herndon
- 11 was a member of Bethany Baptist Church of Murphy and was a past master of the Ocoee
- 12 Masonic Lodge #201; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Herndon was united in love and marriage to his loyal and adoring wife,
- 14 Glenda Little Herndon; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
- 16 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and, by the example he made of his life, he
- 17 made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 18 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Herndon will long be remembered for
- 19 his love of country, family, and friendship, and this loyal husband, uncle, neighbor, and
- 20 friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
