The House Committee on Health and Human Services offers the following substitute to SB 49:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 5 of Chapter 4 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to prescription drugs, so as to limit a pharmacist from substituting a drug as part of
- 3 immunosuppressive therapy; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 4 for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 5 of Chapter 4 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 prescription drugs, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 "26-4-81.1.
- A pharmacist shall not engage in drug product selection or substitution of any primary
- 11 <u>immunosuppressant pharmaceutical that is prescribed as a part of immunosuppressive</u>
- 12 therapy for a patient who has received an organ or tissue transplant without first notifying
- 13 the patient or his or her designee. The pharmacist shall notify the prescribing physician
- prior to the substitution by means of phone, facsimile, or electronic transmission. The
- prescribing physician shall indicate on the prescription the diagnosis 'for organ or tissue
- 16 <u>transplant patient."</u>

SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
