3 with the passing of Ms. Aundra Bolton; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Ms. Bolton had long been recognized by the citizens of this state and her
5 community for the vital role that she played in the teaching profession and her deep personal
6 commitment to the education of the students of Georgia; and
- 7 WHEREAS, a graduate of Morris Brown College, Ms. Bolton began her incredible teaching
8 career in 1979 at Elberton Elementary School, where she dedicated 11 years to molding and
9 inspiring young minds; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Ms. Bolton began teaching fourth grade at Blackwell Elementary School in
11 1990, after a school consolidation with Elberton Elementary School; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Ms. Bolton was devoted to her calling, committed to shaping this nation's future
13 leaders and great thinkers, and was an active member of the Georgia Education Association;

- 15 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Ms. Bolton was a member of New Era
16 Baptist Church where her voice uplifted the spirits of the congregation in the choir; and
- 17 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
18 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made of her life,
19 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

20 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous woman, Ms. Bolton will long be remembered
21 for her love of community, family, and friendship, and this loyal sister, mother, aunt, and
22 neighbor will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing her.
