

ADOPTED

Senators Johnson of the 1st, Wiles of the 37th, Pearson of the 51st, Heath of the 31st, Williams of the 19th and others offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Education and Youth Committee substitute to HB 278 (LC 33 3199S) by*
 2 *inserting after "To amend;" on line 1 the following:*

3 Article 5 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
 4 local school superintendents, so as to prohibit certain actions by local school
 5 superintendents; to amend

6 *By inserting between lines 10 and 11 the following:*

SECTION 0.1

8 Article 5 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to local
 9 school superintendents, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

10 "20-2-101.1.

11 (a) A local school superintendent shall not be eligible to be employed by or be under
 12 contract for any education association, regional educational service agency, or the
 13 Department of Education or any other entity which represents or does business with the
 14 local school system which employed the superintendent until one year after the termination
 15 date of the superintendent's employment or leaving such office.

16 (b) A superintendent employed by or under contract with a local board of education shall
 17 be prohibited from registering as a lobbyist or engaging in lobbying under this article for
 18 a period of one year after terminating such employment or leaving such office."
