- 10 <u>including, but not limited to, pickup trucks, vans, and sport utility vehicles,</u> designed to
- 11 carry ten passengers or less <u>fewer</u> and used for the transportation of persons<u>; provided</u>,
- 12 however, that such term shall not include motorcycles; motor driven cycles; or off-road
- 13 <u>vehicles or farm vehicles as defined in Code Section 40-2-150 being used by an owner,</u>
- <u>driver, or occupant 18 years of age or older but shall not mean pickup trucks, motorcycles,</u>
 motor driven cycles, or vehicles equipped for off-road use, provided that the term
- 16 'passenger vehicle' includes any sport utility vehicle and also includes pickup trucks for any
- 17 occupant who is under 18 years of age."
