A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending David Cano and inviting him to appear before the House of
2 Representatives; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, David Cano has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished rank
4 conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and

5 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
6 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
7 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and

8 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and David
9 has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills taught
10 through the Boy Scout program; and

11 WHEREAS, to earn the rank of Eagle Scout, this dedicated member of Troop 1776 organized
12 and supervised 47 volunteers to build an outside classroom for Queen of Angels Catholic
13 School; and

14 WHEREAS, throughout his years with the Boy Scouts of America, David has earned an
15 astounding 121 merit badges and 20 Eagle Palms, and he has traveled throughout Georgia,
16 Alabama, Florida, North Carolina, New Mexico, Idaho, Montana, Virginia, and Washington,
17 D.C.; and

18 WHEREAS, a junior at Blessed Trinity Catholic High School, David has served as an active
19 member of the Model United Nations, the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, the National
20 Honor Society of Secondary Schools, and his school's band, football, and soccer teams; and

21 WHEREAS, this outstanding Georgian has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
22 principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a manner
23 becoming an Eagle Scout; and

24 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
25 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
27 the members of this body commend David Cano for his diligence and dedication in pursuing
28 the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America, congratulate him on attaining the
29 prestigious rank of Eagle Scout, and invite him to appear before the House of
30 Representatives at a date and time to be determined by the Speaker of the House of
31 Representatives.
