ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

1 Requesting the Georgia Department of Transportation to develop a state rail plan; and for

2 other purposes.

WHEREAS, the Georgia General Assembly has identified that rail is an important asset that
needs to be properly utilized and leveraged; and

5 WHEREAS, it is the intent of this body that the Georgia Department of Transportation 6 develop a state rail plan that will address the present and future needs for rail for both 7 passenger and freight in this state and provide a strategy to address those needs; and

8 WHEREAS, the state rail plan will address the commuter, intercity, higher speed and high

8 WHEREAS, the state rail plan will address the commuter, intercity, higher speed and high 9 speed rail services, freight capacity, as well as multimodal integration of rail with other

10 modes of transportation; and

11 WHEREAS, the state rail plan should be developed in accordance with Chapter 227 of Title

12 49 of the United States Code such that it will allow the state to access federal funds for rail

13 improvements. Without such a plan, the state has no ability to access federal rail monies; and

WHEREAS, it has been more than a decade since Georgia has undertaken a comprehensiverail plan review; and

WHEREAS, other states have active rail planning efforts that examine freight and passengerrail in an integrated fashion and now stand ready to access federal stimulus funding.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the Department of 19 Transportation is requested to develop a state rail plan within 24 months that meets federal 20 requirements and will allow the state to access federal funds.

- 22 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Department of Transportation.
