ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

Creating the Senate Study Committee on Mental Health Continuum Care; and for other
 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the commercial sexual exploitation of minors is often precipitated by

- 5 WHEREAS, most commercially sexually exploited children suffer from a myriad of mental
 6 health problems including depression, post-traumatic stress disorder, substance abuse, and
- 7 sexually transmitted diseases; and

undiagnosed mental health issues; and

8 WHEREAS, many mental health issues are compounded by deficits in life skills such as 9 conflict resolution, problem solving, anger management, and maintaining healthy 10 relationships; and

WHEREAS, research has shown that early childhood trauma such as physical or sexualabuse, or both, affects normal ego development; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a solid understanding of how to best address these
issues which, if left untreated, may establish a group of vulnerable adults that become a drain
on social welfare programs; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of protecting Georgia's youth, it is fitting and proper to investigate and examine the services available across the public and private sectors capable of recognizing and treating mental health issues in minors.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that there is created the Senate
Study Committee on Mental Health Continuum Care to be composed of seven members of
the Senate to be appointed by the President of the Senate. The President of the Senate shall

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- 22 designate a member of the committee as chairperson of the committee. The chairperson shall
- 23 call all meetings of the committee.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs, issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action 25 26 or legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate. The committee may 27 conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or 28 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and 29 accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution. The members of the committee 30 shall receive the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by 31 32 any member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized. 33 The funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from the funds 34 appropriated to the Senate. In the event the committee makes a report of its findings and 35 recommendations, with suggestions for proposed legislation, if any, such report shall be made on or before December 31, 2009. The committee shall stand abolished on December 36 37 31, 2009.
