## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Harold Edwin Caldwell; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Mr. Harold Edwin Caldwell on March 21, 2009; and

4 WHEREAS, Harold Caldwell was born in Floyd County, Georgia, on November 19, 1929,  
5 the beloved son of the late Hugh Keith and Ora Marable Caldwell; and

6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United  
7 States Army, serving in the Korean War, and was honorably discharged following his heroic  
8 military service; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Harold Caldwell humbly served his community as a City of Rome building  
10 inspector, and following his retirement, he remained active in repair and renovation trades;

13 with many social and civic groups, including his service as Commander of the  
14 Shanklin-Attaway American Legion Post #5, Captain of the American Legion Post #5 Honor  
15 Guard, and member of the 40/8 V.F.W.; and

16 WHEREAS, he was a devoted and proud father to his daughter, Cathy Brumbelow, and his  
17 two granddaughters, Jennifer Jean Brumbelow and Allison Renee Brumbelow; and

18 WHEREAS, he was a faithful member of Pleasant Valley North Baptist Church; and

19 WHEREAS, he was a person of great strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for  
20 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness, and, by the example he made of his life, he  
21 made this world a better place in which to live; and

22 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Harold Edwin Caldwell will long be  
23 remembered for his love of family, community, and country, and this loyal husband,  
24 neighbor, and friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
26 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Mr. Harold Edwin  
27 Caldwell and express their deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
