9 was a long-time resident of Ware County; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Mr. Rouse was united in love and marriage to his adoring wife, the late Norma  
11 Jane Townsend Rouse, and was blessed with the love of three children, Judith, Jane, and  
12 William, and six grandchildren; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
14 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he  
15 made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 16 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Rouse will long be remembered for his  
17 love of country, family, and friendship, and this loyal father, neighbor, and friend will be  
18 missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
