A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 19 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to marriage license and ceremony, so as to provide for the public dissemination of
- 3 information relating to sickle cell disease; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 19 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 marriage license and ceremony, is amended in Code Section 19-3-40, which is reserved, as
- 9 follows:
- 10 "19-3-40.
- 11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'blood test for sickle cell disease' means a blood
- 12 <u>test for sickle cell anemia, sickle cell trait, and other detectable abnormal hemoglobin.</u>
- 13 (b) The Department of Human Resources shall prepare information for public
- 14 <u>dissemination on the department's website describing the importance of obtaining a blood</u>
- 15 test for sickle cell disease and explaining the causes and effects of such disease. Such
- information shall recommend that each applicant applying for a marriage license obtain a
- 17 <u>blood test for sickle cell disease prior to obtaining a marriage license. Such information</u>
- 18 <u>may also be provided as a brochure or other document. The department shall make such</u>
- information available in electronic format to the probate courts of this state which shall
- 20 <u>disseminate such information to all persons applying for marriage licenses.</u> Reserved."

21 SECTION 2.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
