## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To abolish the office of elected county surveyor of Lamar County pursuant to Code Section
- 2 36-7-2.1 of the O.C.G.A. and provide for the appointment of a county surveyor; to provide
- 3 for an effective date; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 4 purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 (a) Pursuant to Code Section 36-7-2.1 of the O.C.G.A., the office of elected county surveyor
- 8 of Lamar County is abolished.
- 9 (b) The Board of Commissioners of Lamar County is authorized to appoint a county
- 10 surveyor. The county surveyor shall be appointed for an indefinite term and shall serve at
- 11 the pleasure of the board of commissioners. A county surveyor appointed by the board of
- 12 commissioners shall possess the qualifications as provided in Code Section 36-7-2 of the
- 13 O.C.G.A.
- 14 SECTION 2.
- 15 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 16 without such approval.
- SECTION 3.
- 18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
