## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act providing a new charter for the county-wide government of Columbus,
- 2 Georgia, approved April 5, 1993 (Ga. L. 1993, p. 4978), as amended, so as to provide for
- 3 certain meeting requirements for the Council of such county-wide government; to provide
- 4 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 An Act providing a new charter for the county-wide government of Columbus, Georgia,
- 8 approved April 5, 1993 (Ga. L. 1993, p. 4978), as amended, is amended by revising
- 9 paragraph (4) of Section 3-103 as follows:

- 10 "(4) The Council shall hold at least two regular meetings per month. Special meetings
- of the Council may be called by the mayor or by any six members of the total
- membership of the Council upon no less than 12 hours' written notice to each member
- served personally or left at the usual place of business or residence of such member. Such
- notice of the special meeting may be waived in writing either before or after the meeting.
- 15 Special meetings may be held at any time without notice upon attendance at such meeting
- of, or waiver of notice by, all members of the Council."

17 SECTION 2.

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
