## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,

relating	g to the "Quality Basic Education Act," so as to temporarily suspend certain laws and
require	ements relating to expenditure controls, minimum direct classroom expenditures,
maxim	num class size, additional days of instruction, and salary schedules; to provide for
statuto	ry construction; to provide for automatic repeal of such suspension; to provide for
related	matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
purpos	es.
	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
	SECTION 1.
Article	6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
''Quali	ty Basic Education Act," is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

<u>(a)</u>	From the effective date of this Act through June 30, 2013, the following shall be
suspe	ended and shall not apply to nor be enforceable against a local school system:
<u>(1)</u>	Subsection (a) of Code Section 20-2-167;
<u>(2)</u>	Code Section 20-2-171;
<u>(3)</u>	Subsection (i) of Code Section 20-2-182;
<u>(4)</u>	Code Section 20-2-184.1; and
<u>(5)</u>	Code Section 20-2-212.
<u>(b)</u>	No penalty shall be applied to a local school system for not complying with the
<u>requi</u>	rements contained in the Code sections or provisions referenced in subsection (a) of
this (	Code section, notwithstanding any law to the contrary.
(c) N	Nothing in this Code section shall be construed to repeal any other provision of this
chap	ter.
(d) ]	This Code section shall be automatically repealed on July 1, 2013."

27	This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law

30	All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed
