## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending all 4-H Clubs of Georgia and declaring February 8, 2010, as  
2 4-H Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

4 be champions and serve as outstanding representatives and officers of the young people of  
5 Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Brock Hufstetler of Bartow County serves with distinction and dedication  
7 as State 4-H President; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Arch D. Smith of Cooperative Extension and Interim State 4-H Leader, has  
9 worked diligently with the 4-H Clubs throughout Georgia; and

10 WHEREAS, the leadership, dedication, and hard work of Garrett Hibbs of Oconee County,  
11 Mary Clayton Gilbert of Bartow County, LaVonte Lovette of Jenkins County, and Zachary  
12 Allen of Lowndes County, as District Presidents has been acknowledged by the 4-H  
13 membership in their election of each of these young people to serve as president for 2009-10;

15 WHEREAS, the excellent record of accomplishments in citizenship and leadership of Katie  
16 Comer and Jerico Phillips of Carroll County, Ellie Baldwin of Bleckley County, and Hillary  
17 Thornton of Charlton County, were recognized in Washington, D.C. at the 2009 National  
18 4-H Conference; and

19 WHEREAS, John Scott of Madison County and Mary Singleton of Forsyth County, were  
20 named 2009 Leadership in Action Winners; and

21 WHEREAS, Hunter Brock of Turner County, Ashleigh Marie Day of Peach County, Katie  
22 Thigpen of Charlton County, Ellie Baldwin of Bleckley County, and Hillary Thornton of  
23 Charlton County were named state winners in the 2009 Dean's Awards competition; and

24 WHEREAS, Haley Gilleland of Ben Hill County won the 2009 National Egg Preparation  
25 Demonstration Contest in Louisville, Kentucky.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
27 recognize and commend the University of Georgia College of Agricultural and  
28 Environmental Sciences 4-H Program, Mr. Brock Hufstetler, State 4-H President, Mr. Arch
