## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the 2009 Georgia USGA women's golf team on winning the  
2 USGA Women's State Team Championship and inviting them to appear before the House  
3 of Representatives; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, through perseverance and iron determination, the 2009 Georgia USGA women's  
5 golf team earned national acclaim by winning the USGA Women's State Team  
6 Championship; and

7 WHEREAS, the Georgia women's team dominated their opponents at Sycamore Hills Golf  
8 Club in Fort Wayne, Indiana, with a nine-stroke win at the national event; and

9 WHEREAS, this victory and their 2005 win at Berkeley Hall marks Georgia as the first state  
10 to win multiple titles in the competition since it was established in 1995; and

11 WHEREAS, this 2009 dream team consisted of talented athletes Captain Sissi Gann, Dori  
12 Carter, Laura Coble, and Mariah Stackhouse; and

13 WHEREAS, the phenomenal performance of the team is a clear indication of the outstanding  
14 athletic ability, the dedication and hard work, and the unity of purpose and spirit of each  
15 member of the team; and

16 WHEREAS, as this magnificent team earned its well-deserved reputation for excellence by  
17 performing with courage and precision over months of training and competition, it is  
18 abundantly proper to call them champions.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
20 the members of this body congratulate the 2009 Georgia USGA women's golf team for  
21 winning the USGA Women's State Team Championship and extend their sincere best wishes
