A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 40-6-250 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	wearing a device which impairs hearing or vision while operating a motor vehicle, so as to
3	exempt headsets used for communication purposes; to provide for related matters; to provide
4	for an effective date and applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6	SECTION 1.
7	Code Section 40-6-250 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to wearing a
8	device which impairs hearing or vision while operating a motor vehicle, is revised to read as
9	follows:
10	″40-6-250.
11	No person shall operate a motor vehicle while wearing a headset or headphone which
12	would impair such person's ability to hear, nor shall any person while operating a motor
13	vehicle wear any device which impairs such person's vision; provided, however, that a
14	person may wear a headset or headphone for communication purposes only while operating
15	a motorcycle. This Code section shall not apply to hearing aids or instruments for the
16	improvement of defective human hearing, eyeglasses, or sunglasses. This Code section
17	shall not apply to any law enforcement officer or firefighter equipped with any
18	communications device necessary in the performance of such person's duties."
19	SECTION 2.
20	This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2010, and shall be applicable to all offenses
21	occurring on or after that date.

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
