

## Senate Resolution 900

## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the Chemistry Section of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's Division of  
2 Forensic Sciences on receiving the 2009 August Vollmer Excellence in Forensic Science  
3 Award from the International Association of Chiefs of Police; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, August Vollmer, a former chief of police and president of the International  
5 Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP), is known as the "Father of American Policing" and  
6 promoted the use of new forensics technology, including fingerprinting, polygraph machines,  
7 and crime laboratories; and

8 WHEREAS, the IACP, the world's largest and oldest nonprofit law enforcement organization  
9 that includes over 20,000 law enforcement executives from over 89 countries, established the  
10 August Vollmer Excellence in Forensic Science Award to honor the proactive and innovative  
11 use of forensic technologies by law enforcement; and

12 WHEREAS, on Sunday, October 4, 2009, the Chemistry Section of the Georgia Bureau of  
13 Investigation's (GBI) Crime Laboratory received this prestigious award for developing and  
14 coordinating a successful marijuana identification training program for local law enforcement  
15 agencies in Georgia; and

16 WHEREAS, as a result of this outstanding program, there are over 1,600 officers in Georgia  
17 certified by the GBI Crime Laboratory to analyze marijuana seized in their jurisdictions and  
18 to testify on their findings, allowing marijuana cases to move through the court system more  
19 rapidly than other controlled substance cases; and

20 WHEREAS, because of this program, the laboratory has seen a 98 percent reduction of  
21 marijuana cases tested, which has permitted drug scientists to concentrate their efforts on  
22 more serious drug cases, resulting in better service to the criminal justice community in  
23 Georgia.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
25 commend the Chemistry Section of the GBI's Division of Forensic Sciences on its  
26 outstanding service to the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, the criminal justice community,  
27 this state, and our country.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
29 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Chemistry Section of the Georgia  
30 Bureau of Investigation's Division of Forensic Services, in Decatur, Georgia.
