## A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Ty McCormack on winning a Gold Medal at the USATF  
2 Junior Olympics National Cross Country Chamionships; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, on December 12, 2009, Ty McCormack earned a Gold Medal at the 2009  
4 USATF Junior Olympics National Cross Country Championships in Reno, Nevada, after  
5 completing the five kilometer course in 16 minutes and seven seconds; and

6 WHEREAS, a senior at North Hall High School, Ty led the Trojan Cross Country team to  
7 Hall County and Region championship titles and a fourth place finish at the Georgia High  
8 School Cross Country Championships; and

9 WHEREAS, Ty earned acclaim for Georgia before the national competition by earning the  
10 title of Region 3 Young Men's Champion and finishing 13th in the 2009 Foot Locker South  
11 Regional Cross Country Championships with his personal best of 15 minutes and five  
12 seconds; and

13 WHEREAS, he has been a leader for the Lanier Running Club's Young Men's Team and was  
14 instrumental in the team's Region 3 Junior Olympic title in 2009 with his first place finish;

16 WHEREAS, this stellar young man epitomizes the courage, determination, leadership, and  
17 character necessary to attain excellence in athletic prowess and performance; and

18 WHEREAS, his months of training and perfecting his breathing, stride, and stamina have  
19 been rewarded with his impressive win and earned him the respect and admiration of his  
20 teammates and competitors; and

21 WHEREAS, it is clearly fitting and proper that the superlative abilities of this accomplished  
22 and gifted athlete, as well as the pride, honor, and respect he has brought himself, his school,  
23 and his community, be appropriately recognized.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
25 the members of this body commend Ty McCormack for his unprecedented athletic  
26 performance, congratulate him upon his national title, and extend to him sincere best wishes  
27 for success in the future.
