A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Georgia's high-tech businesses for their efforts in making Georgia a leader in
2 high-tech employment growth and recognizing February 10, 2010, as Technology Leadership
3 Coalition's High-Tech Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Georgia's high-tech businesses have long been recognized for their diligence
5 in making this state a national leader of high-tech employment development and innovation;

7 WHEREAS, the entire State of Georgia benefits from employment growth and wages
8 resulting from a thriving technology industry; and

9 WHEREAS, significant technology infrastructure investments have the potential to boost
10 growth and job creation throughout the Southeast; and

11 WHEREAS, Georgia's high-tech industry added 13,000 net jobs to this state's economy in
12 2007, which was in addition to the nearly 200,000 Georgians already employed in high-tech
13 jobs; and

14 WHEREAS, the purpose of Technology Leadership Coalition's High-Tech Day at the state
15 capitol is to showcase the important role high-tech companies play in Georgia's economy and
16 its future.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 commend the high-tech businesses of Georgia for their outstanding contributions to the
19 economic health of this state and recognize February 10, 2010, as Technology Leadership
20 Coalition's High-Tech Day at the state capitol.
