A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring all firefighters of Georgia and recognizing the 38th Annual Firefighters'
2 Recognition Day; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, each day, firefighters place their own safety on the line to ensure the safety of
4 Georgians and their property; and

5 WHEREAS, from the beginning of their training at the Georgia Fire Academy through their
6 cooperation with the state fire marshal in the investigation of fires and their causes,
7 firefighters give selflessly to protect others; and

8 WHEREAS, Georgia's firefighters exemplify the highest standards of nobility, courage, and
9 selflessness; and

10 WHEREAS, on February 1, 2010, the Vienna Fire Department will cater a delicious
11 barbeque meal in honor of the 4th Annual Georgia Fire Service Appreciation Dinner
12 sponsored by the Georgia State Firefighters Association, the Georgia Association of Fire
13 Chiefs, Georgia Mutual Aid Group, and the Georgia Firefighters Burn Foundation; and

14 WHEREAS, this reception is held in conjunction with the 38th Annual Firefighters
15 Recognition Ceremonies held at the state capitol on February 2, 2010; and

16 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that the firefighters of Georgia be recognized by the
17 members of this body for their outstanding and courageous service to the people of the State
18 of Georgia.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
20 commend each and every firefighter in the State of Georgia for outstanding public service
21 and recognize February 2, 2010, as the 38th Annual Firefighters' Recognition Day.
