A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Part 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to general provisions regarding state sales and use taxes, so as to provide
- 3 a temporary reduction in the amount of certain sales and use tax exemptions; to provide for
- 4 an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Part 1 of Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 8 relating to general provisions regarding state sales and use taxes, is amended by adding a new
- 9 Code section to read as follows:
- 10 "48-8-2.1.
- 11 The provisions of this Code section shall supercede and control over any other provision
- of Code Section 48-8-3 to the contrary which enacted, reenacted, or otherwise extended a
- sales and use tax exemption on or after January 1, 2007. In any such exemption, for the
- period of time commencing with the first day of the month following the month in which
- this Code section becomes effective and concluding January 1, 2013, the amount of such
- sales and use tax exemption shall be reduced by 15 percent."

17 SECTION 2.

- 18 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 19 without such approval.

SECTION 3.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
