11 raiser for the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society; and

13 Republican Women's Club, was named 2000 volunteer of the year by the Chatham County
14 Republican Party, and served as the Chatham County delegate to the Republican National
15 Convention in 2000; and

17 years and was blessed with the love of her faithful dog, Molly Girl Vestal; and
