A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions regarding the General Assembly, so as to provide that it shall be unlawful
- 3 for any member of the General Assembly to receive compensation of any kind or anything
- 4 of value, either directly or indirectly, from any political subdivision located in whole or in
- 5 part in the House or Senate district which such member represents; to provide that it shall be
- 6 unlawful for any political subdivision to employ or pay compensation of any kind or
- 7 anything of value, either directly or indirectly, to any member of the General Assembly
- 8 whose House or Senate district includes such political subdivision in whole or in part; to
- 9 provide an exception; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal
- 10 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

12 SECTION 1.

- 13 Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- provisions regarding the General Assembly, is amended by adding a new Code section to

- 17 (a) It shall be unlawful for any member of the General Assembly to receive compensation
- of any kind or anything of value, either directly or indirectly, from any political subdivision
- 19 <u>located in whole or in part in the House or Senate district which such member represents.</u>
- 20 (b) It shall be unlawful for any political subdivision to employ or pay compensation of any
- 21 <u>kind or anything of value, either directly or indirectly, to any member of the General</u>
- 22 <u>Assembly whose House or Senate district includes such political subdivision in whole or</u>
- 23 <u>in part.</u>
- 24 (c) This Code section shall not apply to school systems."

- 26 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 27 without such approval.
