14 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he
15 made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 16 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Jones will long be remembered for his
17 love of family and friendship, and this loyal husband, father, brother, and friend will be
18 missed by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.
