- 13 WHEREAS, after a career of more than 30 years as a land surveyor on the Georgia coast, Mr.
- 14 Conine committed himself fully to his Abraham Lincoln presentations; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Conine travels throughout the United States and Europe, including Native
  American reservations in Arizona and Germany, delivering his first person portrayal of
  President Lincoln using President's Lincoln personal life experiences, emphasizing honesty,
- 18 integrity, ambition, and patriotism to entertain, educate, and motivate his listeners.

   commend Mr. James Conine for dedicating his life to furthering the principles of President
- 21 Abraham Lincoln.
