## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the National Health Museum; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Georgia General Assembly and the National Health Museum both deem the  
3 rapid advancement of knowledge in health and the health sciences and the creation of new  
4 discoveries and practices in these fields to be of the utmost importance; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the National Health Museum is an unprecedented and historically timely effort  
6 to educate and inspire Americans to live healthier lives; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia is a global crossroads of health and health care and home  
8 to a critical mass of life sciences resources providing the National Health Museum with  
9 remarkable opportunities for collaboration and support; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the National Health Museum, which is to be located in Atlanta, Georgia, will  
11 create and lead a national health and wellness community using innovative digital delivery  
12 platforms, including a multi-channel Cyber Museum providing online and portable  
13 programming services; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the museum will house a one-of-a-kind Experience Museum, providing  
15 immersive self-guided exhibitions focused on life, health, and the human body to more than  
16 one million visitors annually; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the National Health Museum will play a leading role in our national transition  
18 to a culture of wellness, reach out broadly to Americans of all ages, and collaborate with  
19 health efforts in every state through its virtual and physical capabilities; and
- 20 WHEREAS the programs and services of the National Health Museum will help achieve  
21 these goals and provide great benefits to the people of Georgia, our nation, and the world.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
23 recognize and support the National Health Museum and its leadership, including Chairman  
24 Louis W. Sullivan, M.D., and President David H. Roland, in expeditiously achieving its  
25 mission.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
27 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the National Health Museum.
