A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Sarah Murdock, Lumpkin County High School's 2010 STAR Student; and for
2 other purposes.

4 important objective of the General Assembly; and

16 a STAR Teacher that has inspired and encouraged them throughout their high school career;

18 WHEREAS, Sarah chose Lumpkin County High School educator Ms. Julie Hogan as her
19 STAR teacher, who provided support and guidance throughout the years and encouraged
20 Sarah to achieve her utmost potential; and

21 WHEREAS, Sarah has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal adroitness,
22 and personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and

23 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this
24 bright and promising young citizen.
