- 21 (a) The Commission on Regional Planning shall be governed by a board of directors that
- shall initially consist of the following members:

- 30 (6) The commissioner of economic development;
- 31 (7) The commissioner of human services;
- 32 (8) The commissioner of natural resources;
- 33 (9) The commissioner of transportation;
- 34 (10) The director of the Environmental Protection Division;
- 35 (11) The director of the Georgia Environmental Facilities Authority;
- 36 (12) A designee of the Lieutenant Governor;
- 37 (13) A designee of the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and
- 38 (14) A designee of the State School Superintendent.
- 39 (b) The Governor shall serve as chairperson of the Commission on Regional Planning.
- 40 The Governor is authorized to appoint other members to the Commission on Regional
