#### A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mrs. Beverly Ann Stallings Dixon; and for other purposes.

3 with the passing of Mrs. Beverly Ann Stallings Dixon on January 22, 2010; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mrs. Dixon was born on October 4, 1955, in Cleveland, Ohio, a beloved  
5 daughter of Eloise Stallings and the late Tommie Stallings; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mrs. Dixon attended Morris Brown College, where she met and later married  
7 Theodore L. Dixon, a loving union which blessed her with three sons, Daryl, Lee, and  
8 Brandon; and
- 9 WHEREAS, she began her career with Wachovia Bank, where her leadership, organizational  
10 skills, and vision were recognized with promotions within the company; and
- 11 WHEREAS, she devoted her time, talents, and energy as a flight attendant with Air Tran  
12 Airways, where she was recognized by her peers with an Air Tran Excellence Award in  
13 2005; and
- 14 WHEREAS, a woman of deep and abiding faith, Mrs. Dixon accepted Christ at an early age  
15 while at New Hope Baptist Church in New Jersey and was an active member of the Anointed  
16 Choir of Faith at Trinity A.M.E. Church; and
- 17 WHEREAS, an immaculate dresser, Mrs. Dixon enjoyed shopping, decorating her home,  
18 reading, and spending time with her family; and
- 19 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
20 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to  
21 her family and friends was admired by others; and

22 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
23 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made of her life,  
24 she made this world a better place in which to live; and

25 WHEREAS, Mrs. Dixon will long be remembered for her love of family and friendship, and  
26 this loyal daughter, wife, mother, and friend will be missed by all who had the great fortune
