## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to issuance, expiration, and renewal of drivers' licenses, so as to provide for the
- 3 notation on drivers' licenses of a diagnosis of post traumatic stress disorder; to provide for
- 4 certification; to provide for procedures; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 issuance, expiration, and renewal of drivers' licenses, is amended by adding a new Code
- 9 section to read as follows:
- 10 "40-5-38.
- 11 (a) Members of the armed services and veterans who have been diagnosed with post
- 12 <u>traumatic stress disorder may request to have a notation of such diagnosis placed on his or</u>
- her driver's license. Such applicant shall present the department with a sworn statement
- 14 from a person licensed to practice medicine or psychology in this state verifying such
- diagnosis.
- 16 (b) The commissioner shall by rules and regulations establish procedures necessary to
- 17 carry out the provisions of this Code section including, without limitation, application
- forms and an appropriate symbol to be placed on the drivers' licenses."

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
