A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 60 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions relative to counties and municipal corporations, so as to provide a short
- 3 title; to provide that no local governing authority shall prohibit the construction of a fence
- 4 between properties of a sufficient height to prevent a person at the highest point of
- 5 observation in one residence to observe activity within an adjacent property; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

9 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Child Protection Act."

SECTION 2.

- 11 Chapter 60 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 12 provisions relative to counties and municipal corporations, is amended by adding a new Code
- 13 section to read as follows:
- *"*36-60-27.
- No county, municipality, consolidated government, or local governing authority shall limit
- the maximum height of a fence or wall to a measurement less than that which is required
- 17 <u>to prevent a person at the highest point of observation within one residential zoned</u>
- 18 structure from observing any person or activity in any point within the fenced or walled
- 19 area of an adjacent residential zoned property."

20 SECTION 3.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
