A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to revenue and
- 2 taxation, so as to repeal Chapter 7, relating to income taxes; to prohibit the levy or collection
- 3 of income taxes; to provide for applicability; to provide that this Act shall not abate or affect
- 4 prosecutions, punishments, penalties, administrative proceedings or remedies, or civil actions
- 5 related to certain violations; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to
- 6 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to revenue and taxation, is
- amended by repealing in its entirety Chapter 7, relating to income taxes, and enacting a new
- 11 Chapter 7 to read as follows:
- 12 "<u>CHAPTER 7</u>
- 13 <u>48-7-1.</u>
- On or after January 1, 2011, there shall be no income taxes whatsoever levied or collected
- by the state or any political subdivision thereof, and no income tax returns shall be
- 16 required."
- 17 SECTION 2.
- 18 (a) This Act shall become effective January 1, 2011.
- 19 (b) Income tax, penalty, and interest liabilities and refund eligibility for prior taxable years
- 20 shall not be affected by the enactment of this Act and shall continue to be governed by the
- 21 provisions of general law as it existed immediately prior to January 1, 2011.

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22 (c) This Act shall not abate any prosecution, punishment, penalty, administrative

- 23 proceedings or remedies, or civil action related to any violation of law committed prior to
- 24 January 1, 2011.

25 SECTION 3.

26 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
