| 11 | (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'public lobbyist' means any person connected by |
| 12 | employment, agency, or contract with the executive or judicial branch of this state, any |
| 13 | agency or authority of this state, any political subdivision or association of political |
| 14 | subdivisions of this state, or any entity created by the laws or Constitution of this state. |
| 15 | (b) No public lobbyist shall be permitted to address any committee, subcommittee, or joint |
