A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide for standing to bring an action
- 2 to challenge the constitutionality of a law; to provide for the submission of this amendment
- 3 for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Section I of Article I of the Constitution is amended by designating the text of Paragraph
- 7 XXIX as Paragraph XXX.

- 8 SECTION 2.
- 9 Said article is further amended by adding a new Paragraph XXIX to read as follows:
- 10 "Paragraph XXIX. Standing. Any citizen of this state shall have standing to challenge
- the constitutionality of any law enacted by the General Assembly."
- SECTION 3.
- 13 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- 15 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:
- 16 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to provide that any
- 17 citizen of this state shall have standing to bring an action to challenge the
- 18 () NO constitutionality of any law enacted by the Georgia General Assembly?"
- 19 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 20 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- become a part of the Constitution of this state.
