A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 16-11-127 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 carrying weapons in unauthorized locations and penalty, so as to repeal a prohibition against
- 3 carrying a weapon in a place of worship; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting
- 4 laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 16-11-127 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to carrying
- 8 weapons in unauthorized locations and penalty, is amended by revising subsection (b) as
- 9 follows:

- 10 "(b) A person shall be guilty of carrying a weapon or long gun in an unauthorized location
- and punished as for a misdemeanor when he or she carries a weapon or long gun while:
- 12 (1) In a government building;
- 13 (2) In a courthouse;
- 14 (3) In a jail or prison;
- 15 (4) In a place of worship;
- 16 (5) In a state mental health facility as defined in Code Section 37-1-1 which admits
- individuals on an involuntary basis for treatment of mental illness, developmental
- disability, or addictive disease; provided, however, that carrying a weapon or long gun
- in such location in a manner in compliance with paragraph (3) of subsection (d) of this
- 20 Code section shall not constitute a violation of this subsection;
- (6) (5) In a bar, unless the owner of the bar permits the carrying of weapons or long guns
- by license holders;
- 23 (7) (6) On the premises of a nuclear power facility, except as provided in Code Section
- 24 16-11-127.2, and the punishment provisions of Code Section 16-11-127.2 shall supersede
- 25 the punishment provisions of this Code section; or

- 26 (8) (7) Within 150 feet of any polling place, except as provided in subsection (i) of Code
- 27 Section 21-2-413."

28 SECTION 2.

- 29 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 30 without such approval.
- 31 SECTION 3.
- 32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
