A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 6 of Chapter 4 of Title 18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to continuing garnishment proceedings, so as to extend the effective period of a
3 continuing garnishment; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date and
4 applicability; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Article 6 of Chapter 4 of Title 18 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
8 continuing garnishment proceedings, is amended by replacing the phrase "one hundred
9 seventy-ninth" with the phrase "five hundred thirty-ninth" and by repealing the phrase "one
10 hundred ninety-fifth" with the phrase "five hundred fifty-ninth" where ever such phrases
11 appear in:

- 12 (1) Code Section 18-4-111, relating to property, money, or effects subject to continuing
13 garnishment;
14 (2) Code Section 18-4-113, relating to contents of summons of continuing garnishment
15 and filing and contents of answers; and
16 (3) Code Section 18-4-118, relating to forms for continuing garnishment.

17 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 2.**

18 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2011, and shall apply to garnishments filed on or
19 after such date.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
