## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Subpart 6A of Part 3 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of
- 2 Georgia Annotated, relating to tuition grant assistance for North Georgia College and State
- 3 University, so as to provide tuition grant assistance for students attending Georgia Military
- 4 College similar to military students attending North Georgia College and State University;
- 5 to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date and applicability; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Subpart 6A of Part 3 of Article 7 of Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 10 Annotated, relating to tuition grant assistance for North Georgia College and State
- 11 University, is amended by revising Code Section 20-3-440, relating to legislative findings,
- 12 as follows:
- 13 "20-3-440.

- 14 The General Assembly finds that it is essential for the national defense that persons be
- 15 encouraged to consider military leadership positions as an honorable and rewarding
- profession and that North Georgia College and State University, Georgia's only state
- supported military college, plays and Georgia Military College play a significant role in
- preparing and training students for professional life in the military as a profession. It is the
- purpose of the General Assembly, as provided for in this subpart, to encourage students to
- 21 <u>its military training program Georgia Military College</u> and to encourage such students to

enroll in the military training programs of North Georgia College and State University and

- accept military commissions by providing for tuition grant assistance to such students."
- SECTION 2.
- 24 Said subpart is further amended by revising Code Section 20-3-442, relating to amount of
- 25 grant, as follows:

- 26 "20-3-442.
- 27 (a) There is granted to each eligible student attending North Georgia College and State
- 28 University the sum of \$1,500.00 per academic semester.
- 29 (b) There is granted to each eligible student attending Georgia Military College the sum
- 30 of \$1,000.00 per academic quarter."
- 31 SECTION 3.
- 32 Said subpart is further amended by replacing "North Georgia College and State University"
- 33 with "North Georgia College and State University or Georgia Military College" wherever
- 34 such term appears in:
- 35 (1) Code Section 20-3-441, relating to eligible student defined for purposes of receiving
- tuition grant assistance;
- 37 (2) Code Section 20-3-443, relating to application for grants, certification of eligibility,
- and refunds; and
- 39 (3) Code Section 20-3-445, relating to audits of the college.
- 40 SECTION 4.
- 41 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2011, and shall apply to applications received on
- 42 or after such date.
- 43 SECTION 5.
- 44 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
