15 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and

16 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader  
17 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
19 commend Casey Yeomans for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest honor  
20 awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious  
21 rank of Eagle Scout.
