## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Michael "Mickey" Eugene Neidenbach; and for other  
2 purposes.

4 with the passing of Mr. Michael "Mickey" Eugene Neidenbach on January 20, 2011; and

16 wonderful years, and was blessed with the support of his remarkable children, Libby  
17 Neidenbach, John and Patty Neidenbach, and Tony Neidenbach; and

18 WHEREAS, in addition to his parents, wife, and children, Mr. Neidenbach leaves behind  
19 many who will cherish his memory, including his brother and sister-in-law, Tony and Ann  
20 Neidenbach, and their children, Audrey and Sam; his brother and sister-in-law, Peter and  
21 Beth Neidenbach, and their children, Charles, Sarah Glenn, Charlotte, and Thomas; his

22 in-laws, Elizabeth Ann and Ed Cassady; and his brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Michael  
23 and Mary Reins, and their son Byron; and

24 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
