- 12 positions, including manager of audit and special projects and corporate director of financial
- 13 services; and
- 14 WHEREAS, he was elected in 2006 to represent House District 136, which includes parts
- of Bibb, Crawford, Houston, Lamar, Monroe, Peach, and Upson counties; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Representative Sellier served on the House Committees on Agriculture and
- 17 Consumer Affairs, Defense and Veterans Affairs, Education, and Health and Human

- 19 WHEREAS, Representative Sellier was united in love and marriage to his wife, Judye, and
- 20 was blessed with three remarkable children, Rodney, Heather, and Amy; and
