11 Atlanta Bible Baptist Church, where she wrote missionary letters and sang tenor in the choir;

- 15 WHEREAS, Mrs. Marshall was known for her unique sense of humor, her jolly laugh, and

18 Annie Marble, Doris Littlejohn, and Evelyn Bostock, and numerous nieces and nephews; and

19 WHEREAS, she gave inspiration to many through her high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
20 for her fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding she demonstrated to  
21 her family and friends were admired by others; and

22 WHEREAS, she was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
23 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example she made of her life,  
24 she made this world a better place in which to live; and
