A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 28-7-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 prohibition of contingency compensation of lobbyists, so as to provide that such prohibition
- 3 shall not apply to bona fide commission salespersons and that such salespersons shall not be
- 4 required to register as lobbyists or otherwise be considered to be lobbyists; to provide for
- 5 related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Code Section 28-7-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the prohibition
- 10 of contingency compensation of lobbyists, is amended by designating the existing text of the
- 11 Code section as subsection (a) and adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 12 "(b) The prohibitions on contingent compensation contained in subsection (a) of this Code
- section and in subsection (a) of Code Section 21-5-76 shall not apply to, and shall not
- prohibit the retention or employment of, a bona fide commission salesperson who acts in
- 15 that capacity with respect to governmental procurements; and such a bona fide commission
- salesperson shall not be required to register as a lobbyist or otherwise be subject to the
- provisions of Article 4 of Chapter 5 of Title 21."
- 18 SECTION 2.
- 19 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- without such approval.
- SECTION 3.
- 22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
