## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending Robert Bryan Struble; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Robert "Bobby" Bryan Struble has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most  
3 distinguished rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a  
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques  
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and  
8 Bobby has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special skills  
9 taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this amazing achievement is even more exceptional given that Bobby is also a  
11 cancer survivor, having been diagnosed with Leukemia at the age of four; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Bobby first joined the Boy Scouts of America program in 2000 and has  
13 attended adventure treks such as Philmont Scout Ranch, High Adventure Trip, Sea Base in  
14 the Bahamas, and Harpers Ferry in Virginia; and
- 15 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 226 and has demonstrated  
16 great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of America  
17 program; and
- 18 WHEREAS, a senior at Wesleyan School, Bobby has held the offices of Quartermaster,  
19 Historian, Chaplain, Patrol Leader, Assistant Patrol Leader, and Senior Patrol Leader; and
- 20 WHEREAS, to earn the rank of Eagle Scout, Bobby designed and constructed an ultimate  
21 frisbee golf course on his school's campus for students, faculty, and parents to enjoy; and

22 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Bobby has truly exhibited a commitment to the  
23 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a  
24 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and

25 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader  
26 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
28 the members of this body commend Robert Bryan Struble for his diligence and dedication  
29 in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him  
30 on attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
