- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Harry Steine; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens
3 with the passing of Mr. Harry Steine on January 27, 2011; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Steine was born and raised in Warrenton, Georgia, was a long-time resident
5 of Augusta, and was 102 years old; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served as a guardian of this nation's freedom and liberty with the United
7 States Army, valiantly and courageously protecting his fellow Americans during World War
8 II in the North African and Italian campaigns; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Steine graduated from the University of Georgia, was admitted to the
10 Georgia Bar in 1934, and practiced law in Augusta for over 65 years; and
- 11 WHEREAS, a dedicated community leader, Mr. Steine served on the Augusta City Council
12 for 12 years; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Steine was united in love and marriage to the late Cecil Steine and his
14 memory will be cherished by numerous nieces and nephews and close friends; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern
16 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his
17 family and friends were admired by others; and
- 18 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation
19 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he
20 made this world a better place in which to live; and

21 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Steine will long be remembered for his
22 love of family and friendship, and this loyal uncle, friend, and neighbor will be missed by
23 all who had the great fortune of knowing him.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Mr. Harry Steine and
26 express their deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
