- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Mr. Spencer Pass; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Mr. Spencer Pass on January 31, 2011; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a native of Atlanta, Georgia, Mr. Pass had served as a Department of  
5 Transportation HERO operator for the past two years; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he diligently and conscientiously devoted his time, talents, and energy to  
7 assisting the traveling public of Georgia who found themselves in need of roadside  
8 assistance; and
- 9 WHEREAS, on January 31, Mr. Pass was fatally injured in the line of duty while rendering  
10 aid to a motorist on Interstate 85; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Mr. Pass was united in love and marriage to his supportive wife, Dawn, and he  
12 was blessed with three remarkable children; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and deep concern  
14 for his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his  
15 family and friends were admired by others; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he was a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation  
17 for integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness and, by the example he made of his life, he  
18 made this world a better place in which to live; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Mr. Pass served with honor and distinction as a Georgia Department of  
20 Transportation HERO operator and his dedication and unyielding commitment set the  
21 standard for public service; and

22 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Mr. Pass will long be remembered for his  
23 love of family and friendship, and this loyal son, husband, father, and friend will be missed  
24 by all who had the great fortune of knowing him.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
26 join in honoring the life and memory of Mr. Spencer Pass and express their deepest and most  
27 sincere regret at his passing.
