## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 43-26-3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
definitions relative to the "Georgia Registered Professional Nurse Practice Act," so as to
revise a definition; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

| 12 | An 'approved nursing education program' located outside this state means a nursing           |
| 13 | education program that the board has determined to meet criteria similar to and not less     |
| 14 | stringent than criteria established by the board. In order to be approved by the board, a    |
| 15 | nursing education program must be one that is offered by:                                    |
| 16 | (A) A unit of the University System of Georgia accredited by the Commission on               |
| 17 | Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools;                                |
| 18 | (B) An institution of the Technical College System of Georgia accredited by the              |
| 19 | Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools;                  |
| 20 | (C) A nonprofit postsecondary institution of higher education that is accredited by a        |
| 21 | regional accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education;         |
| 22 | or   |
| 23 | (D) A proprietary institution of higher education that is accredited by a regional           |
| 24 | accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education; or               |
| 25 | (E) A nonprofit postsecondary institution of higher education that is a four-year            |
| 26 | institution whose credits or degrees are accepted for credit by at least three other         |
|    |  |

- 27 postsecondary institutions of higher education that are accredited by a regional
- 28 accrediting agency recognized by the United States Department of Education."

## 29 **SECTION 2.**

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
