5 Lindsey; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a senior at Valdosta High School, James was a 4.0 student, an athlete, and loved
7 the outdoors; and
- 8 WHEREAS, James disappeared after falling out of a boat while duck hunting in Lake Park,
9 Georgia; and
- 10 WHEREAS, James had the potential to achieve great things, and his passing has left his
11 family, friends, school, community, and this state saddened and stunned; and
- 12 WHEREAS, by the example James made of his life, he made this world a better place in
13 which to live, and though his life was cut tragically short, James's memory and example will
14 live on through the many lives he touched; and
- 15 WHEREAS, James will long be remembered for his love of the outdoors, family, and
16 friendship, and this loyal son, brother, classmate, and friend will be missed by all who had
17 the great fortune of knowing him.

19 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of James Eunice and express
20 their deepest and most sincere regret at his passing.
