A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Samuel Wallace Marcotte, Madison County High School's 2011 STAR
2 Student; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, a proper quality education for the young people of this state is the single most
4 important objective of the General Assembly; and

5 WHEREAS, Samuel Wallace Marcotte has shown by the example of his academic
6 accomplishments that the pursuit and attainment of scholastic success are within the reach
7 of the students in this state; and

8 WHEREAS, this remarkable scholar has earned distinction through his superlative
9 achievements at Madison County High School where he is a gifted student and was selected
10 as Madison County High School's 2011 STAR Student; and

11 WHEREAS, to be selected as a STAR Student for a high school, a student must have
12 obtained the highest score in one administration of the new three-part Scholastic Aptitude
13 Test taken through the November test date of his or her senior year and be in the top ten
14 percent or top ten students of his or her class; and

15 WHEREAS, each school has one STAR Student who in turn has the opportunity to choose
16 a STAR Teacher that has inspired and encouraged them throughout their high school career;

18 WHEREAS, Samuel chose Madison County High School educator Mr. Trenton Wilkes as
19 his STAR teacher, who provided support and guidance throughout the years and encouraged
20 Samuel to achieve his utmost potential; and

21 WHEREAS, he has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal adroitness, and
22 personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and

23 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this
24 bright and promising young citizen.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
26 heartily commend Samuel Wallace Marcotte for his spectacular scholastic endeavors,
27 recognize him for being named Madison County High School's STAR Student for 2011, and
